2022 NoVA NPHC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The National Pan-Hellenic Council, Inc. (NPHC) is an umbrella organization for nine historically black, international Greek letter fraternities and sororities. NPHC was formed as a permanent organization on May 10, 1930, on the campus of Howard University in Washington, DC. NPHC promotes community awareness and action through educational, economic, and cultural service activities.

The National Pan-Hellenic Council of Northern Virginia (NoVA NPHC) was established in 1966 and has grown to be one of the most active chapters in the national council. Each year the NoVA NPHC grants two (2) \$1,000 scholarship awards to TWO high school graduating seniors who plan to attend an accredited four-year college or university upon graduation.

Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for this scholarship, **you must:**

- Be a high school graduating senior with cumulative grade point average of 3.2 on a 4.0 scale.
- Have submitted an application to enroll with intent to attend or have been accepted as a full-time student to an accredited four-year college or university beginning Fall 2022
- Be a resident of one of the following Northern Virginia Counties/Cities (Alexandria, Arlington, Fairfax, and Falls Church)
- **Be identified by your guidance counselor (or career development director) as a 2022 Black Scholar**
- **Attend the Black Scholars Awards Program on Sunday, May 15, 2022 3:00 – 5:00 pm (arrival time is 2:00 pm)**
****Failure to attend the in-person awards program may result in forfeiture of the scholarship.**

Application Deadline

Complete (and **typed**) application packages must be *received (or postmarked) by Thursday, March 31, 2022.*

How to Apply

The Scholarship Committee will review only those applications that are complete with supporting documents and meet all scholarship requirements. For your application to be complete, you must submit the following:

- **TYPED** scholarship application form & **TYPED** addendum
- A copy of school transcript
- Two (2) letters of recommendation. One from each of the following individuals written on official letterhead, dated and signed.
 - Teacher
 - Guidance Counselor
- Essay (500 words or less) on the topic:
Over the past few years (since March 2020), COVID-19 has completely consumed and disrupted all of our lives with virtual classes, social distancing, and a lack of social and athletic events. As a student transitioning to college, please explain how these changes have affected you as it relates to your environment (e.g., family, school, involvement in sports, health, etc.). Please also include your thoughts on how COVID-19 has (or has not) had a disproportionate impact on African Americans.
